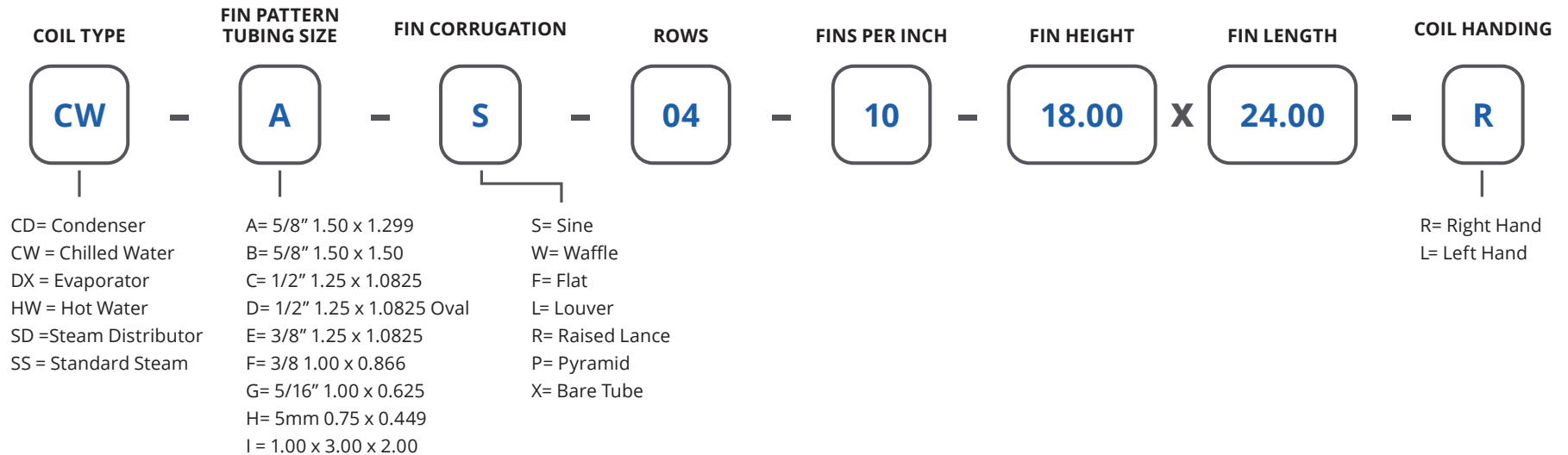




Updated Coil Model Number Nomenclature — Effective 2026

Effective 2026, Coilmaster’s coil model string format has been revised. The updated structure removes circuiting from the model number, separates tubing size and fin geometry into distinct fields, and explicitly defines fin corrugation. These changes standardize the format and support expanded product configurations.

EXAMPLE: CW-A-S-04-10-18.00x24.00-R



Key Changes

1. Circuit Identifier removed from model number
2. Fin-tube pattern and fin corrugation type separated into two fields
3. Handing Simplified – Legacy: RH / LH. Current: R / L.

Unchanged Fields

- Coil Type codes
- FPI designation
- Dimensional structure (Height x Length)
- Two-digit row format (e.g., 04)
